

Board Meeting  
Superior Township Regular Meeting  
November 8, 2006

The regular meeting of the Superior Township Board was called to order at 7:00 P.M.

Roll Call of Members: W. Hyvarinen, M. Charles, K. Munson, C. Compo, and W. Beaune. All members of the board were present.

Visitors: Frank Toms, Cathy Collins, Wayne Gady, Deb Freedman, Patty Hopper, Ken Graham, and Walt Parish.

Frank Toms, Fire Chief, stated that they had one run over the last month, and this was due to downed power lines.

Motion by C. Compo and supported by W. Beaune to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

Motion by K. Munson and supported by W. Beaune to adopt the minutes of the previous meeting dated October 11, 2006 Regular Meeting and delete the 5th paragraph of the Special Meeting minutes. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

Old Business:

Frank Toms, Water and Sewer Superintendent, met with Jim Granger, Engineer, about the Atkinson Road Sewer Project to check the area out to make sure everything will go in. There are some changes that will need to be done to make it work from the original plans.

Wimpy Smith said his surveying stakes have never been put back in from when the water was put in on Atkinson Rd. by Underground Specialists. We will have them put back after the sewer project on Atkinson is complete.

New Business:

Motion by C. Compo and supported by W. Beaune to accept the agreement with Edison Sault Electric for use of their poles for holiday signage by the Lions Club. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

Walter Parish, Clinic Coordinator, from Bay Mills Health Services, attended our regular meeting to discuss with our township their appreciation of our letter of support for their services and also some of the services associated with the million-dollar grant they received. 41 people from our

township are on the sliding fee which includes clinic visits, drugs, War Memorial Hospital visits and dental. The cost of these services is a minimum of \$10.00 and maximum of \$55.00. Other services include mental health and home health service. The clinic is also in the process of hiring another doctor and a female practitioner.

Motion by K. Munson and supported by W. Beaune to purchase two storage units for the office and one bulletin board for the town hall from National Office Products for \$1,065.90. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

#### Reports:

Supervisor: Roads - Resurfacing M-28 from M-221 east to I-75. M-123 from Paradise to the Tahquamenon Falls.

Contract - Goldade Road 1 mile \$54,630.00. Motion by K. Munson and supported by C. Compo to do the one mile of building up and black topping the one mile of Goldade Road. ½ will be paid up front and the other ½ when finished. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

#### Treasurer's Report:

Motion by M. Charles, and supported by C. Compo to accept the treasurer's report as presented. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

Motion by K. Munson and supported by W. Beaune to pay the bills in the amount of \$43,570.22. Motion adopted with all members voting yes.

#### Clerk's Report:

A thank you card was received from Soo Motors for purchasing the new Ford truck from them.
