

**Board Meeting  
Superior Township Regular Meeting  
August 9, 2006**

The regular meeting of the Superior Township Board was called to order by Supervisor, Walter Hyvarinen at 7:02 P.M.

Roll Call of Members: W. Hyvarinen, M. Charles, K. Munson, C. Compo and W. Beaune. All members of the board are present.

Visitors: Patty Hopper, Deb Freedman, Frank Toms

Frank Toms – Moved computer used at the fire hall for fire reports to DPW building. The internet provider on this particular computer had been jamadots but along with the move of the computer, the internet provider was switched to Bay Mills, as this will save the Township \$180.00 per year. (This computer will not just be used for fire reports now, but also water and sewer.)

Motion by C. Compo and supported by W. Beaune to adopt the agenda as presented. Motion adopted, with all members voting yes.

Motion by C. Compo and supported by K. Munson to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting dated July 12, 2006. Motion adopted, with all members voting yes.

Motion by K. Munson and supported by C. Compo to have the Township cover the cost of the PPO for Patty Hopper against Dennis Quinn. Motion adopted, with all members voting yes.

Motion by K. Munson and supported by M. Charles to advertise for sealed bids to replace the sidewalks. The sidewalks are 5' wide, approximately 2,700 ft., 4" concrete, 4000 PSI with fiber mesh. Motion adopted, with all members voting yes.

**Complaints:**

A request was made to post "slow children at play" sign on Crawford St. Motion by C. Compo and supported by K. Munson to purchase a sign to be posted on Crawford St. Motion adopted, with all members voting yes.

There will be a letter written to Theresa Alcorn about the mold on the outside of her trailer on Lake Street Loop. The letter will also be sent to Chippewa County Health Department.

**Reports:**

Supervisor – The Gladys Crossing Road is now paid off. There is bridge work being done on Beaune Road. Black topping will be done on Water Tower Lane when the County has blacktop ready for roads.

The township received a complaint from Bonnie LaPonsie about Terri Rabineau burying her two stillborn babies at the foot of her mother's grave. The family wants Terri to remove them and the headstone from that gravesite. Our ordinance does not cover this issue. They will have to hire an attorney or work it out between themselves.
